

Good eating on a bun at Dave's Dogs

DESTIN – The Memorial Day holiday is upon us, signaling the emotional, if not the actual, start of summer.

With that, thoughts turn to summer food, and it is hard to imagine any food being more identifiable with summer than the hot dog.

When hot dogs are what you are looking for, a trip to Dave's Dogs is in order. There are two locations, one at Destin Commons and one at Silver Sands Factory Stores.

The Destin Commons site is at the center plaza of the shopping complex in a kiosk with a fun retro feel. Seating is available in the area around the kiosk, which is adjacent to the playground.

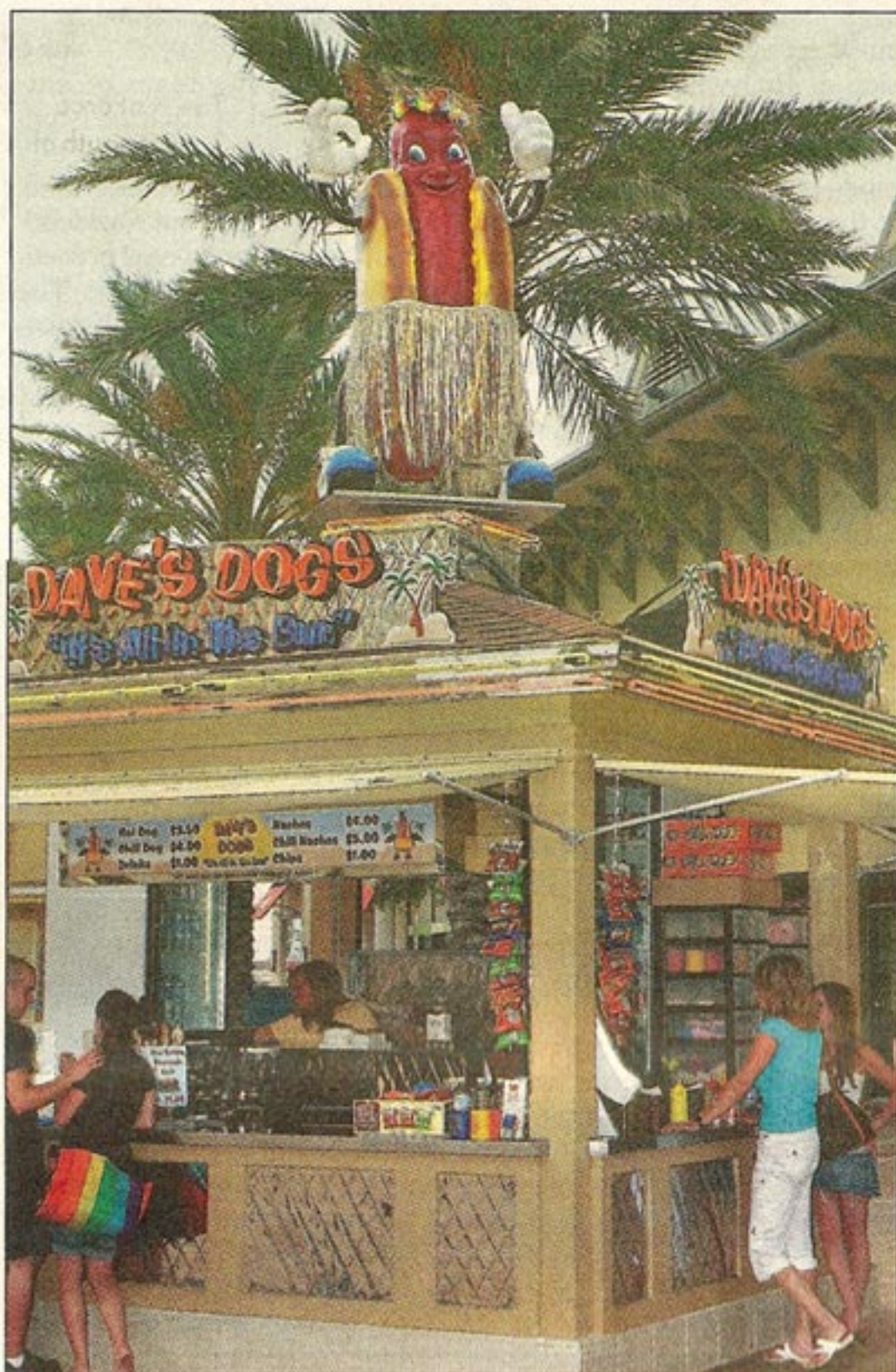
Silver Sands' Dave's Dogs is less visible, tucked into a corner of the shopping center (next to Le Creuset). The outdoor tables and chairs are surprisingly sturdy and comfortable.

A third location is set to open soon, adjacent to a car wash near the Okaloosa-Walton County line on U.S. Highway 98. Unlike the other two locations, this one will have a drive-up window.

Dave's Dogs catches your attention initially with its mascot, an anthropomorphic hot dog that wears sunglasses and a grass skirt. But what holds your attention is the hot dog itself.

The hot dog is of good quality, but as Dave's Dogs' slogan points out, "It's all in the Bun."

The buns are not standard hot dog buns. They are the variety used for lobster rolls in

Maine.

What looks like a folded piece of Texas toast has a flat bottom and is split at the top. It also has flat sides that make it perfect for grilling.

Dave's Dogs grills the buns on each side adding buttery flavor to the sweetness of the

bread. The result is a crisp golden brown exterior and soft interior.

Once the bun is grilled, it is time to fill it (although it would be great by itself). The two options on Dave's Dogs' short menu are hot dogs and chili dogs.

On the counter are other condiments that you can add yourself. Sauerkraut, pickle relish, chopped onions, pickled jalapeno slices, and shredded cheese are all offered.

The rest of the menu is nachos, chili nachos, chips and drinks.

Nachos are a guilty pleasure. They are simple tortilla chips topped with bright yellow cheese sauce. I liberally top mine with jalapenos.

They are made even better with the addition of Dave's Dogs' chili. The chunky meat chili has a lightly sweet flavor.

Bottled water and soft drinks are offered. So are chips, including Miss Vickie's potato chips, which have great crispness. When we visited, Miss Vickie's jalapeno seasoned chips were available.

Service at Dave's Dogs was friendly, and the staff has enthusiasm for the product they are selling. Hours vary, but Dave's Dogs hours are generally based around the shopping centers' hours.

Because of the kiosk location, payment for Dave's Dogs is geared around cash.

Dave's Dogs doesn't try to do too much. The menu is short, the prices good, and it is easy to pick up a dog during a shopping excursion.

With its twist on the usual hot dog bun, Dave's Dogs has taken the hot dog to a new level, making it an even nicer way to herald the coming of summer.

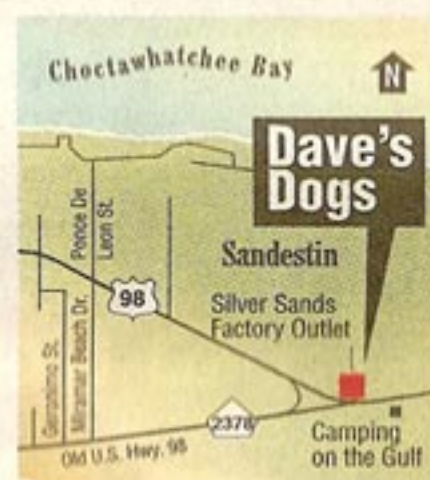
